PUNK STITCH

Monika Cvitanović 2.2.24 – 18.2.24

Monika Cvitanovic is a Croatian-born artist and a PhD candidate (UNSW) living on Gadigal land. Deeply interested in the histories embedded in textiles and preoccupied with her impact on the environment, she explicitly works with reclaimed materials to counter expectations of neoliberal economies. Her repetitive messy stitching also serves as a method of rebellious care that rejects patriarchal values of perfection.

Relating to this approach as punk, Deep space is filled with works that feature a selection of well-worn shirts (*Remediation*) and with assemblages of sewing offcuts (*seam stress*) held together by repetitive messy cross-stitches. The artist often uses needlework as a way to record time and perhaps highlight the invisible labours behind garments such as these reclaimed shirts. The assemblages of remnants and sewing offcuts seek to animate rejected textiles in circulation while the display of compositions plays with the tradition associated with painting to challenge the gendered hierarchy of art disciplines and materials.
